- 4) It was followed by a talk on the "Treatment outcomes in patients treated under DOTs program" by Dr. Vijay Kumar.
- 5) Next, Dr. S.V. Lavanya had given an insight into the "SOP for Tuberculosis case detection, diagnostic algorithm and investigation flow charts".
